ADJUSTED CONTRIBUTION LIMIT FOR THE MARCH 5, 2024 STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION

Dear Mr. Chemerinsky:

The County of Los Angeles Campaign Finance Ordinance requires the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to provide written notification to each candidate of the applicable contribution limit. On December 8, 2023, a candidate for the Los Angeles County Office of District Attorney filed a Form 800 Election Campaign Declarations for the March 5, 2024 Statewide Direct Primary Election agreeing to be bound by the Voluntary Expenditure Limit (VEL) set forth for this office at \$2,511,981.50 and selected Option 2, the "In excess of \$50,000, but not more than \$100,000 option".

Based on your Form 800, you agreed to be bound by the VEL and selected Option 1, the "\$50,000 personal funds limit option". Pursuant to Proposition B, a candidate who commits to the \$50,000 personal funds limit and agrees to the VEL will have their contribution limit adjusted if any of their opponents adjusts their personal funds option (Los Angeles County Code 2.190.070 A). Thus, your contribution limit for the March 5 2024 Statewide Direct Primary Election has been increased to \$7,500.
